Why does Solidarisch in Gröpelingen offer legal consultation?

The legal consultation is a part of our political goal to fight together for a society without exploitation and oppression.

The legal consultation is about your questions and concerns.

As a district union, it is important for us to help people from Gröpelingen to clarify their problems and thus relieve them of stress.

For us, however, it is not over with the solution of your concern. Many people have similar worries as you and we don't want to be faced with the same problems again and again. We want to identify the causes of the problems and get rid of them together.

For this we need you, too!

Who is Solidarisch in Gröpelingen?

Solidarisch in Gröpelingen is a political and social organization.

We are a district union.

We do not get paid for our work. We are not social workers. We are independent from the state, parties, authorities and companies.



We want to solve problems together with many people and fight their causes collectivly.

These are some of the problems: stress with employers, the Jobcenter and landlords. Racist laws, violence against women and in families, more and more poverty, a broken health system, the destruction of the environment.

Our goal: Together we want to create a different and solidary society, we want a good life for all!

How do we want to achieve our goal?

In the district union many people come together. We offer counceling on different topics, organize actions together like rallies or demonstrations and meet at social activities, such as communal breakfasts or movie nights. Regularly we meet at the general assembly.

Only if we fight united and keep together, we can change something.

But we cannot achieve our goal only in Gröpelingen. Also in other districts, cities and countries we need groups like Solidarisch in Gröpelingen and patience and strength.



What is the Assembly and why is it important?

The heart of Solidarisch in Gröpelingen is the general assembly.

In this plenary meeting, we come together and talk about the problems that often come up during the consultations and whether and how we can do something about them collectivly. We also talk about what is happeing in the neighbourhood, and if that's good or bad. But it doesn't stop at talking: In the meeting, we plan activities and actions.

An action can be, for example, to go in a group to the Jobcenter, when one of us has problems there and demand a solution together.

An activity can be to distribute the next edition of our newspaper or to cook for the neighbourhood.
